Sowing seeds of technology...

ACTT conducts sensitisation seminars and exhibitions to forge new partnerships

ACTT continues to plant seeds of Information Communication Technology (ICT) in homes, schools, businesses and organisations throughout Tanzania. By spreading ICT information and skills, ACTT's refurbished computers, services and trainings promise to make a significant contribution to national development.

In November, ACTT appeared at an ICT exhibition at the centrally located Equator Hotel in Arusha town. AA Computers, the host of the exhibition, invited various companies and organisations to participate in the two-day event. The objective was to demonstrate a wide range of ICT providers to the general public.

One of ACTT's greatest ambitions as an ICT provider is to establish Computer Technology Learning Centres (CTLCs) in as many schools as possible throughout Tanzania's northern zone. Specifically, the goal is to reach at least two thirds of all Tanzanian schools (with electricity) by the year of 2011. The exhibition at the Equator Hotel was therefore a welcome opportunity to promote the "Support a School" campaign - whereby ACTT links schools with supporters willing to fund a CTLC.

During the exhibition, ACTT was visited by students and teachers from several schools as well as members of the general public - the visitors book was filled with 150 new names, and 250 people walked away with ACTT brochures and price lists. In fact, as a result of visiting this exhibition, three new schools are now in the process of joining the "Support a School" program!
